

Primary and Secondary Education at Village Jakhania

In the rural areas of Kutch, due to the difficult economic circumstances, social taboos, and a lack of educational awareness, even the very basic need for good education becomes a challenge.

In order to empower children with the gift of education, Veerayatan has started many schools in the area, either highly subsidized or totally free. Quality education with life skills and values at nearly no cost has become a



real boon for the local communities. This initiative has helped disadvantaged children tremendously in realizing their full potential.

- The school at Veerayatan Vidyapeeth has brought the first experience of formal education for numerous children and the first ever secondary schooling for many girls
- The well-rounded education here includes physical education, co-curricular activities with a pivotal focus on making them good human beings
- In a remote area of Kutch, the scholastic achievements of the students in this school stand well in parallel to the city schools with all resources available.



Primary Education at Rudrani

Veerayatan Vidyapeeth, Rudrani is a unique initiative for the empowerment of hundreds of those children for whom education was an unattainable dream. To these children coming from low-income, rural and backward tribal communities, education at Veerayatan Vidyapeeth is a priceless opportunity to change the paths their lives will take. At Veerayatan, the education has instilled confidence and enthusiasm in them and their parents are also thrilled to see their children going to school for the first time in generations.



- The Rudrani school provides free education to the children of families who migrated from the border areas of Kutch after the earthquake in 2001
- In addition to all other basic amenities like uniforms, books and stationery free of charge, regular transportation, nutritious breakfast and midday meal are also provided without any cost to the students
- Because of the holistic approach of learning at the school, the Rudrani center has become a focal point and a place of hope for the entire local community
- Since its inception, there has been a vast increase in the number of girls at the school because of the continuous dialogue of the Sadhvijs with the local people regarding the importance of female literacy
- At present, the strength of the school is more than 500 students and the plan is to make a difference in the lives of a thousand students.
